## Red and Blue Day Information Note 2017

On Thursday 21st September, the Year 7 and 8 students of St. Joseph's High School will challenge the students from Corpus Christi High School in our Annual Red and Blue Day Challenge!

Red and Blue day is an event designed to increase the relationships between our two schools as well as provide an opportunity to develop school spirit and allow an opportunity for students to display their many talents. Details for the day are as follows:

- Date:** Thursday 21st September, 2017  
**Venue:** Croome Rd Sporting Complex.  
**Transport:** Students will come to school as normal. After homeroom buses will take students to the venue. In the afternoon buses will pick students up from Croome Rd Sporting Complex and return them to school in time for scheduled buses home.  
**Activities:** Students have already selected activities they wish to participate in from Netball, Soccer, Rugby League, Touch, Basketball, Oz-Tag, 7 / Side Rugby Union, Dodgeball as well as non-sporting activities such as a photography competition (must provide own camera) and chess.  
**Uniform:** Students are required to wear **full sports uniform** on the day. Playing attire (eg footy jumpers) will be supplied as needed. Students are required to supply all personal protective equipment (eg football boots, mouthguards etc). Students must wear lace up joggers (**not volleys or slip on shoes**). Students wearing incorrect footwear will be required to help the teachers all day. Students should wear their sports hat and apply sunscreen regularly during the day.  
**Attendance:** Red and Blue day is a compulsory community day and therefore all Year 7 and 8 students are expected to attend and participate. Students who need to leave early must have a note signed by their parents presented to the office for a Pass Out and must leave the venue with their parent(s). Rolls will be marked at the commencement and conclusion of the day.  
**Canteen:** There will be a limited canteen available. Please ensure your child has adequate food and drink for the day. Drink bottles are highly recommended to use during activities.  
**Permission Note:** By signing the blue 'St Joseph's Annual Permission Note 2017', and ticking the box for "Red & Blue Day With Corpus Christi" you have given consent for your child to attend this excursion. If you have not returned this note, or you have not ticked this box, please contact the School to arrange for another note to be sent home.

As mentioned above, students have already chosen their activities. Parents are encouraged to discuss these choices with their child to ensure that they are aware of the activities they will be participating in on the day. Students who have selected Rugby League or Rugby 7's will need to complete an additional permission slip.

As always, parents are welcome to come and be a part of the day and any assistance that can be provided will be gratefully accepted.
