## Downie Shield Cricket

Dear Parents/Guardians,

Your son has been selected to represent St. Joseph's Catholic High School against Corpus Christi Catholic High School in the first round of the Downie Shield Senior Boys Cricket Competition. Details for the event are as follows:

- Date:** Friday 20th October, 2017
- Location:** Shane Lee Oval, Oak Flats (to be confirmed)
- Time:** 8:15am for a 9am start. Estimated finish time is around 3:00pm. Students are asked to bring mobile phones to keep parents informed of estimated finishing time.
- Transport:** Private transport to and from the venue is required
- Cost:** \$10.00 per player
- Payment:** **Online Payment is our preferred payment method for this activity.** Go to the school website [www.sjchsdown.catholic.edu.au](http://www.sjchsdown.catholic.edu.au) Homepage, Excursion Letters and Payments and select the relevant link. **This link closes at 3.30pm on the final payment date.** Alternatively, payment can be made at the front office via cheque/cash or eftpos.
- Uniform:** Students **MUST** wear school sports uniform. Players are to get changed into playing whites (a shirt will be provided to play in).
- Equipment:** Players are responsible for providing their own personal protective equipment (pads, gloves etc). The school will provide batting helmets if required. In accordance with school safety guidelines it is highly recommend that players wear a helmet when batting.
- Canteen Facilities:** None provided, please bring all drinks and food for the day as required.

In the instance of the event being cancelled (eg wet weather) a notice will be placed on the school website. Those involved with the event are also encouraged to download the St Joseph's 'Skoolbag' app for their mobile phones as a cancellation message will be pushed straight to your phone. Students will be required to attend school as normal if the game is called off.

### **NOTE:**

1. There is limited shade available. Players are expected to wear hats and provide their own sunscreen.
2. Students are required to bring enough water to ensure they stay hydrated throughout the duration of the day.
3. The Downie Shield is a statewide knockout. The winner of this game will progress to the next round of the competition which may involve travel out of the area.
