Year 10 End Of Year Activities 2017

In Week 9 of this term Year 10 students will be completing their First Aid Certificate and participating in a range of activities.

Students will spend two days completing their training and assessment for the First Aid Certificate. The course will be run by Barrington's First Aid and students will receive a certificate upon the completion of this course. *Students need to begin working through the theory component of the course by completing their electronic workbook at home. Students will not receive their certificate if they haven't completed this theory component.*

Students will also participate in a variety of activities during this week that will aim to prepare them for the challenges of both academic and social life. These activities include a presentation on drug and alcohol safety from the Police Liaison Officer; completing the NESA mandated *All My Own Work* course; a presentation from students at UOW and some online courses and activities.

During this time, the students will be walking to and from Albion Park Pool/Con O'Keefe Oval for some activities. They will also be travelling by bus to the Fire and Rescue Training Centre at Albion Park airport to learn about road safety, motor vehicle accidents and to witness a simulated car accident rescue.
