Transport:	Bus. (Provided by the school both to and from both venues)
Where:	 We are on two retreat sites, with the year group split in half 'Winbourne Conference Centre', Mulgoa Ph: 4773 5555 'The Hermitage' (Le Rosey Site), Mittagong Ph: 4872 1911
Time:	Depart school at 8:30am on Wednesday, 30 October and we will return by 3:00pm on Friday, 1 November 2019.
Supervision:	The Retreats will be fully supervised day and night by our St Joseph's staff. The same rules which apply to drugs and alcohol at school apply at the retreat.
	In the instance of major breaches of discipline, parents will be contacted to come and collect their son or daughter at any time of day or night.
What to Bring:	Casual clothes, toiletries, sleeping bag and pillowcase, 2 towels (one old). Students will NOT be permitted to use their mobile telephones at the retreat, except when permission has been given (by a teacher) for taking photos or listening to

music during allocated times. This is a time to get away from the technological environment and to spend time with friends to develop relationships, selfawareness and growth in faith.
